

# How the Creator views His creation

---

## There are 6 Types of Kingdoms

**Mineral**  
**Plant / Vegetable**  
**Sea & Air Creatures**  
**Animal Creatures**  
**Human**  
**Heavenly**

The Holy Bible tells us in Genesis chapters 1 and 2 that God created the heavens and earth in six literal days and rested on the seventh day. This is affirmed in the book of Exodus:

**Exodus 20:11** For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day..." (See Appendix #1)

There is a progression in His creation from dirt to mankind. The mineral kingdom was created first followed by the plant kingdom... finally with the human kingdom.

### **Mineral Kingdom (on 3<sup>rd</sup> day of creation)**

**Genesis 1:9-10** And God said...let the dry *land* appear: and it was so. And God called the dry *land* Earth...

### **Plant / Vegetable Kingdom (on 3<sup>rd</sup> day of creation)**

**Genesis 1:11** And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, *and* the fruit tree yielding fruit...

### **Sea & Air Creatures (on 5<sup>th</sup> day of creation)**

**Genesis 1:21** And God created great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind...

### **Animal Creatures (on 6<sup>th</sup> day of creation)**

**Genesis 1:25** And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth...

### **Human Kingdom (on 6<sup>th</sup> day of creation)**

**Genesis 1:26** And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

The Human Kingdom is unique from all the other kingdoms in these four ways:

- 1) Made in Likeness & Image of God

**Genesis 1:26** "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness..."

God, a Triune God has created humans as triune beings. God is primarily a Spirit that has personality so He can commune with humans who primarily are personalities that have a spirit.

2) Man Was Created to Rule over Other Kingdoms

**Genesis 1:26** And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have **dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

(*Dominion* means 'to rule over')

3) Can Fellowship / Commune with God

**Genesis 3:8-10** And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden. And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where *art* thou? And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I *was* naked; and I hid myself.

4) Accountable to the Creator After Death

**Hebrews 9:27-28** And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment...

**Psalms 98:9** Before the LORD; for he cometh to judge the earth: with righteousness shall he judge the world, and the people with equity.

**Everything Stays Within its Own kingdom**

- Grass, Herb & Trees all Reproduce After its Own Kind:

**Genesis 1:11-12** And God said, Let the earth bring forth **grass**, the herb yielding **seed**, *and* the fruit **tree** yielding fruit **after his kind**, whose seed *is* in itself, upon the earth: and it was so. And the earth brought forth grass, *and* herb yielding seed **after his kind**, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed *was* in itself, **after his kind**: and God saw that *it was* good.

- Cattle, Creeping things & Beasts all Reproduce After their Own Kind:

**Genesis 1:24-25** And God said, Let the earth bring forth **the living creature after his kind, cattle**, and **creeping thing**, and **beast** of the earth **after his kind**: and it was so. And God made the beast of the earth **after his kind**, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that *it was* good.

- Creatures Stay Within their Own Flesh

**1 Corinthians 15:38-39** But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body. All flesh *is* not the same flesh: but *there is* one *kind of* flesh of men, another flesh of beasts, another of fishes, *and* another of birds.

- Humans always reproduce other humans

**Genesis 5:3** And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat *a son* in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth...

- The Bible teaches that sinners always reproduce sinners

Adam, the first man, sinned against God and as a result all inherit his sinful nature. All humans are in this "kingdom of sinners."

**Romans 5:12** Wherefore, as **by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men**, for that all have sinned:

**Hebrews 9:27-28** And as it is **appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment**: So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

We will only die one time, and then we will give an account to the Creator. We will be judged by our words and deeds.

**Matthew 12:36-37** But I say unto you, That **every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment**. For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

**Revelation 20:12** And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book of life*: and the **dead were judged** out of those things which were written in the books, **according to their works**.

Our sin separates us from God. No matter how good we try to be, our sin outweighs our goodness.

**Isaiah 59:2** But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid *his* face from you, that he will not hear.

Even Gautama himself preached that while our good deed is as big as a mustard seed, our bad deed is already as big as a kilo. What will you do with your sin? The Creator has a way for you to receive forgiveness of sins. It is amazing to feel a clean heart before the Creator. The Holy Bible tells us how to be forgiven.

God had a plan. Jesus Christ, the Son of God and God the Son, left His heavenly kingdom to make a way for sinful humans to be forgiven and to become a part of a heavenly kingdom in the world to come. This would take a miracle – in fact, it was a miracle.

### **Changing from One Kingdom to Another**

A creature can evolve within its own kind. Dogs may change within their species, but they are still dogs. Birds may have different types of beaks, but they are still birds. Humans may have different colored skin, different sizes and shapes, but they are all still humans.

It is a miracle to move from one kingdom to another kingdom. Only God and His Son, Jesus Christ can change something from one kingdom to another. No tree can become an animal and no human can become an animal. Notice the working of the Creator:

God, the Creator did many miracles. Some of these miracles involved the Creator changing something from one kingdom to another. Here are some examples: (See Appendix # 2)

- God created man (human) from the dust (mineral) of the earth:  
**Genesis 2:7** And the LORD God formed man *of* the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.
- Jesus left heaven (heaven) to take form of a man (human):  
**Matthew 1:23** Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name **Emmanuel**, which being interpreted is, **God with us**.

**Phil. 2:6-8** Who, **being in the form of God**, thought it not robbery to be equal with God...and took upon him the form of a servant, and **was made in the likeness of men**: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself...

**John 1:1** In the **beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God**.  
**John 1:14** And the **Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us**, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth...

**1 Timothy 3:16** And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: **God was manifest in the flesh**, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

Jesus was not just a god, He was God Himself. He was part of the Triune God - God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit make up the Triune Godhead. Humans are also a triune being. You have a body, a soul (mind, will and emotions) and a spirit (conscience, and the reality that you are a spiritual being). You would agree that there is just one of you – yet you have three distinct parts. It is the same with God – there is only one God, yet three distinct parts. (See Appendix #3)

### **What was the Purpose for Christ to Leave the Heavenly Kingdom and Come into our Human Kingdom?**

We inherit our sinful nature from Adam. Jesus Christ came to earth so that we can inherit His heavenly kingdom. When we receive Jesus Christ as our personal Savior, we are now a part of both kingdoms. God performs a miracle by putting us into His heavenly kingdom while we are still alive in the human kingdom! Ponder this verse:

**Colossians 1:13** Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath **translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son**:

Notice all that is stated in the Holy Bible in the verses that surround Colossians 1:13:

**Col 1:12** Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be **partakers of the inheritance** of the saints in light:

**Col 1:13** Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son:

**Col 1:14** In whom we have redemption through **his blood, even the forgiveness of sins**:

**Col 1:15** **Who is the image of the invisible God**, the firstborn of every creature:

**Col 1:16** For **by him were all things created**, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

**Col 1:17** And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

**Col 1:18** And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all *things* he might have the preeminence.

**Col 1:19** For it pleased *the Father* that **in him should all fulness dwell**;

**Col 1:20** And, having **made peace through the blood** of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, *I say*, whether *they be* things in earth, or things in heaven.

**Col 1:21** And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in *your* mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled...

We all are sinners in this human kingdom represented by Adam. Ponder what the Holy Bible states in these verses. Notice what we receive from Adam and what Jesus Christ offers:

**Ro 5:12** Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

**Ro 5:15** But not as the offence, so also *is* the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the **gift by grace, which is** by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.

**Ro 5:16** And not as *it was* by one that sinned, *so is* the gift: for the judgment *was* by one to condemnation, but the **free gift is** of many offences **unto justification**.

**Ro 5:17** For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the **gift of righteousness** shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)

**Ro 5:18** Therefore as by the offence of one *judgment came* upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one *the free gift came* upon all men **unto justification of life**.

**Ro 5:19** For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall **many be made righteous**.

**Ro 5:20** Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:

**Ro 5:21** That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto **eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord**.

Everyone is in the kingdom of humans and has a sinful nature of Adam. The question is: "Are you also in the heavenly kingdom of Jesus Christ?" It is attained by faith in his blood. When one turns to Jesus Christ and receives Him as their own personal Savior, they are placed by the Creator into this heavenly kingdom.

**Colossians 1:13** Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath **translated us** into the **kingdom of his dear Son**. (*translated* means the same as *transfer*)

**John 5:24** He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is **passed** from **death unto life**.

(Passed = going from one state to another)

### Salvation is a Creation of God

- **Ephesians 2:8-10** For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, **created** in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them
- **2 Corinthians 5:17** Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a **new creature**...
- **Ephesians 4:24** ... put on the new man, which after God is **created** in righteousness...

### After Death – All the Saved Will Be Robed in White!

- **The human kingdom was created from the dust (mineral kingdom) of the earth**

**Genesis 2:7** And the LORD God formed man *of* the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

**Genesis 3:19** In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou *art*, and unto dust shalt thou return.

- **Those of the Human Kingdom that have Received Jesus Christ as Savior will be Robed in White in the Heavenly Kingdom!**

**Daniel 7:18** But the saints of the most High shall take the kingdom, and possess the kingdom for ever, even for ever and ever.

**Revelation 5:9** And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation...

**Revelation 7:9** After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

**Revelation 7:14** ...These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

**Ponder these truths and make sure you have trusted in the blood of Jesus Christ to forgive your sins.**

**If God has spoken to your heart, open your heart and ask Jesus Christ to forgive your sins and by faith receive Him as your Savior.**

Do you hear the Holy Spirit knocking on the door of your heart? Jesus said, “Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.” (Revelation 3:20)

The Holy Bible says, “Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice, Harden not your hearts”...(Hebrews 3:7-8)

35 years ago, I discovered this truth and prayed a simple prayer to God and asked Jesus to forgive me and to come enter my heart. He did just that and now I am sharing with you this good news. May you find true forgiveness and peace from God’s own Son, Jesus Christ. (See also Appendix #4)

### #4 More Truths about the Creator & His Creature

- God is eternal in both time & space

**Psalms 90:2** Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even **from everlasting to everlasting**, thou *art* God. **(TIME)**

**Isaiah 57:15** For thus saith the high and lofty **One that inhabiteth eternity**, whose name *is* Holy...

- God is the Triune God **(SPACE)**

**Ecclesiastes 12:1** Remember now thy Creator in the days of thy youth...

The word for "Creator" is the participle of the Verb *bara*, which is that used in **Gen. 1:1**, describing God's work. It is plural in form.

**Genesis 1:1** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Hebrew word for 'God' is 'Elohim' – a plural word *El* = the Highest One

- Places that His creatures may dwell (people / beings)

**Revelation 5:13** And every creature which is in **heaven**, and on the **earth**, and **under the earth**, and such as are in the **sea**, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, *be* unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.
