### He is Creator

**Genesis 1:1** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

**Genesis 1:26** And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

**Isaiah 44:24** Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I *am* the LORD that maketh all *things*; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

**Isaiah 42:5** Thus saith God the LORD, he that created the heavens, and stretched them out; he that spread forth the earth, and that which cometh out of it; he that giveth breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein:

**Isaiah 45:18** For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I *am* the LORD; and *there is* none else.

### He is Great over His creation

**Isaiah 40:22** *It is* he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof *are* as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:

### He is the only God

**Isaiah 43:10-11** ... ye may know and believe me, and understand that I *am* he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. I, *even* I, *am* the LORD; and beside me *there is* no saviour.

**Isaiah 44:6** Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I *am* the first, and I *am* the last; and beside me *there is* no God.

**Isaiah 45:5-6** I *am* the LORD, and *there is* none else, *there is* no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me: That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that *there is* none beside me. I *am* the LORD, and *there is* none else.

**Psalms 90:1-2** Lord, thou hast been our dwelling place in all generations. Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou *art* God.

**Isaiah 45:22** Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I *am* God, and *there is* none else.

1 Samuel 2:2 There is none holy as the LORD: for there is none beside thee...

**Psalms 99:5** Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his footstool; *for* he *is* holy.

**Isaiah 6:1-3** ...I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne... Above it stood the seraphims...And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, *is* the LORD of hosts: the whole earth *is* full of his glory.

Isaiah 57:15 For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy...

**Revelation 4:6-8** ...And round about the throne, *were* four beasts ...And the four beasts...rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

## Did You Know You Are a Sinner?

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Ecclesiastes 7:20 For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.

Romans 3:10 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

# Did You Know Jesus is The Only Way for Forgiveness of Sin?

Rom. 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

**Ephesians 1:7** In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

**Colossians 1:14** In whom we have redemption through his blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins:

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Acts 16:30-31 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

You need to open your heart and receive Jesus Christ as your personal Savior.

John 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name:

**Ephesians 2:8-9** For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

## Truly ponder these great words Jesus said. He wants to dwell in <u>your</u> heart – but you must open the door to your heart to receive Him:

**Revelation 3:20** Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

Would you ask God to forgive your sin & invite Jesus Christ into your heart? If yes, then invite Him through prayer. (Prayer means talking to God)

The best you know how – talk to God and ask for forgiveness and give your heart to Jesus Christ. I did this 35 years ago, and He truly is Wonderful. Go ahead, trust Him today. Don't delay. Stop & invite Him today.

He spoke of your heart: "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me." Would you do this now? Yes, now.

## Did You Know What Happens When You Believe?

God imputes (puts on your account) the righteousness of Jesus Christ.

Romans 4:5-7 But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works, *Saying*, Blessed *are* they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered.

Imagine that God would proclaim that a sinner is now *righteous*! Righteous – right like God is righteous.

2 Corinthians 5:21 For he hath made him *to be* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

**1** Corinthians **1:30-31** But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.

Jude 1:24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

When God forgives, He forgets. He gives and forgives. We get and forget. Isn't He a Loving Father!
